Originally serving a practical function, these historical sheets comprise natural history illustration, designs for the decorative arts, architectural and engineering plans, and plein air studies. The curatorial perspective of pairing traditional art forms on paper with contemporary artistic practice is one that has been central to the gallery's program since its inception in 2004.

As the new year turns and our anniversary year ends, we invite viewers to look beyond conventional divisions in mediums and genres to consider the pleasures and questions raised by linking a breadth of objects through aesthetic and conceptual connections. Organized within loose thematic groupings, each wall offers a fresh context for experiencing contemporary art and objects of material culture from distant eras.
